

Code of Conduct St. Pius X High School

STUDENT-ATHLETE EXPECTATIONS

Selection and participation on a St. Pius X Athletic team should be considered a privilege. As a student-athlete you are held to a high standard. Your conduct is subject to more scrutiny than the average student is; subsequently, your behavior must be exemplary both on and off campus, reflecting the goals and mission of St. Pius X High School. You are a reflection of the school to the community in every way. Yours is a great responsibility that should not be taken lightly.

Listed below are the general athletic department rules and regulation that will be enforced. Coaches of individual sports may add to these rules and regulation with specific team rules and procedures. As a member of the St. Pius X athletic program you are expected to meet these standards and abide by the rules. Disregard of any of these policies, may result in the loss of participation in St. Pius X athletic programs and privileges pertaining to the program. **Any punishment as a consequence for infractions of an athletic department rule will be in addition to the school punishment.** Before playing any sport, the Code of Conduct acknowledgement form must be signed by the student and parent/guardian.

GENERAL ATHLETIC POLICIES

Behavioral infractions such as smoking, cheating, vandalism, inappropriate language, possession or consumption of alcohol or drugs and/or any other serious infraction (See SPX Parent/Student Handbook) will be handled by the school as well as by the athletic department. Once the school has decided the student's consequence the dean of students, in conjunction with the athletic director and coach, will decide the athletic consequence. This consequence may include the student's suspension from participation in all sports for the remainder of the student's career at St. Pius X High School.

Curfew regulations, in addition to city/county curfews, may be set. Each individual sport's coach will administer consequences.

Tardiness to Practice

- The student - athlete must bring a note to the head coach explaining the reason for late arrival to practice.
- Procedures for dealing with unexcused tardiness to practice will be left up to the individual sport's coach.

Missing Practice

- The student-athlete or parent/guardian must make verbal contact with the Head coach prior to practice time. A note from a doctor, parent/guardian, etc., may be necessary for admittance to the next day's practice pending circumstances. Consequences for failure to abide by these rules will be left to the discretion of the head coach.
