**OTHER TUITION NOTES**

Student's tuition due on July 1 and August 1, including late fees, must be paid before the student can pick up class schedule and be admitted to fall classes.

Withdrawals-	Parent/guardian is responsible for the tuition for the entire month in which the student withdrew.
New student-	Parent/guardian is responsible for the tuition for the current and prior month in which the student begins classes.

### Financial Aid

The deadline for financial aid applications for the 2008-09 school year was February 1, 2008. After February 1, applications for financial aid for the 2008-09 school year are available through the Business Office only for transfer students and students that have a family status change. The family status change includes divorce; birth or adoption of a child; death of a spouse or child; loss of employment; involuntary reduction of hours worked or medical illness.
