

WHAT IS THE RAFFLE?

The raffle is a school-wide fundraiser supporting the general operations at St. Pius X.

It is driven by the student-led Raffle Promotions Committee (RPC), which is supported by the Advancement Department.



RAFFLE 101




- The Big Race Raffle kicks-off with a pep rally on Thursday, January 26, in the gym. It will begin at 9:30 a.m. The student raffle committee will be called to the gym at approximately 9 a.m.
- At the conclusion of the pep rally, students will report to their advisory family to collect their raffle packets.
- Each packet will contain 16 raffle books and 5 raffle collection envelopes.
- One raffle book contains 3 tickets and costs \$20. Single tickets may be sold for \$10 each, but not encouraged.
- All students are asked to sell \$320 (16 books) in raffle tickets to earn holidays and other incentives
- Faculty/Staff may sell or not sell. If fac/staff do not sell tickets, their incentives will be earned via progress of their advisory family.
- On Collection Days, students will meet with their advisory family to turn in their tickets (this will be about 15 minutes first thing in the morning).
- Students may sign-up for Phonathon nights and Parish Sales after Mass. Advancement is coordinating and will communicate.
- Students earn holidays if they hit their goals. Seniors will receive an additional holiday (on Friday, April 14 prom) if they sell \$360 in tickets (which is two extra books).

RAFFLE 101 - continued



- For example: If "Johnny" sells more than his quota, he may not transfer his sells (give credit) to another student.
 - Why? It's not fair to Johnny because he did the work; it may impact his incentive awards; and it's not fair to other students.
- All tickets MUST be filled in. Blank tickets will be discarded.
- Once a collection envelope has been sealed, do not open!
- Extra tickets will be available from the Advancement office, second floor of the White Science building.



COLLECTION DAYS



On Collection Days, students will meet as an advisory family. Students will turn in their collection envelopes to their Advisor who will record the total that they wrote on the envelope onto the provided raffle ticket tracker.

The RPC representative will pick-up envelopes and tally sheets and deliver to the Lilly Conference Room for counting and tabulation by volunteers and the Advancement Office.

Lunch Line Cut Pass & Jeans!

Students who sell all tickets are allowed to wear jeans in good repair with a SPX shirt on Fridays during the raffle campaign. These students will wear an orange wristband. So, the quicker all tickets are sold, the more Friday Jeans Days!
