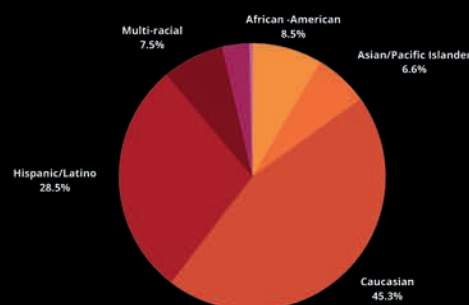
Our student body is diverse, representing more than 60 Catholic parishes and 121 zip codes across the community.

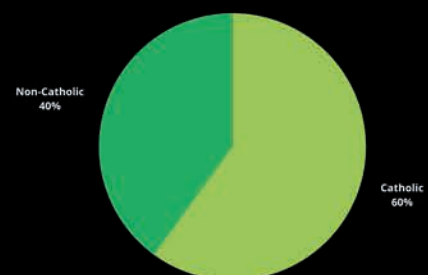
