Rugby at St. Pius X High School began in the fall of 2008 when Mr. Larry Monks, a teacher at SPX and former rugby player, introduced the sport on campus. It was originally formed as a club sport, which began playing as a Division II team in Texas. The team grew in numbers and skills in those early years becoming a very formidable opponent, winning the Texas State High School Division II Championship in 2010.

In 2011, the team became a varsity sport at SPX and was promoted up to Division I, allowing them to compete against the top teams state-wide. Although SPX has always been the smallest school-based rugby team in the state (based on student enrollment), it has almost always finished at or near the top of its league. Finishes included reaching the quarterfinals in 2012, 2013 and 2017, along with semifinals in 2011 and 2018, and recently being named state finalist in 2019.


Along the way, the program has produced many stellar athletes who have fared well at the collegiate level and beyond. After the 2011 season, Matt Schick was recruited by the University of Alabama and was recognized as an All-Southeastern Conference player for three years. He continued his career with the Austin Rugby Football Club as he pursued his master's degree at the University of Texas.


In 2013, two SPX players, Sebastian Schwartz and Chandler Clark, received full athletic scholarships to Wheeling Jesuit



University. Many other SPX rugby players have gone on to receive scholarships and grants, allowing them to play in college.


In 2012 and 2013, the team made its first two tours to New Orleans. In addition to competing in two matches, Coach Lowell Locke arranged community service projects. In 2012, the team served with Café Hope, a job training organization for cooks and restaurant workers designed to help





he felt up to it. A rugby scholarship fund was established in his honor. Since 2014, over \$25,000 has been awarded to thirteen SPX rugby players to help with their post-SPX education.

In the spring of 2014, current SPX athletic trainer, Jeremy Kallus, received a request through the Fellowship of Christian Athletes from the Minister of Sport-Rugby in the Ukraine. They requested donations of rugby equipment and balls to distribute to local teams. SPX Rugby sent shirts, balls

In 2015, the Panthers hosted and played in their first "international" match against St. Maximilian Kolbe High School from Toronto, Canada. It proved to be a huge success. Among the attendees was the sitting Mayor of the City of Houston, Anise Parker. She was introduced to players on both teams and presented the visitors with a city proclamation saluting their visit to Houston.



In 2017, Coach David Selby decided he wanted to help raise funds for SPX students in need of tuition assistance. The SPX rugby team asked for a "pass the hat" gate donation at that final home game to help



raise money for need-based tuition assistance at SPX. This initiative exceeded expectations raising more than \$5,200.

Team Captain Parker Johnson presented the donations to Head of School Ms. Carmen Garrett Armistead.

Since 2016, members of the SPX Rugby program have helped the Salvation Army Houston-Northwest Corp facility's annual "Angel Tree" Christmas program, which distributes gifts to area families in need. Team members hand out over 3,000 gift parcels during the two-day effort each year.
