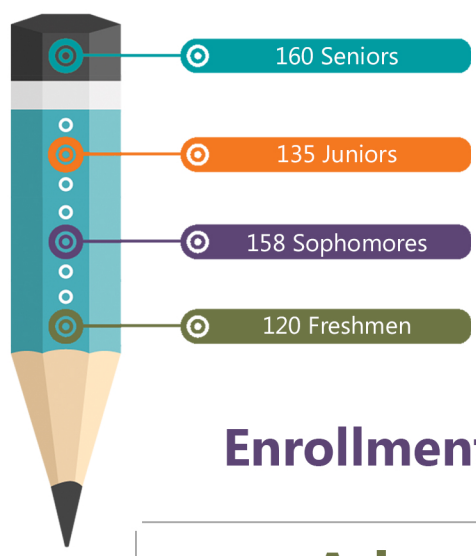

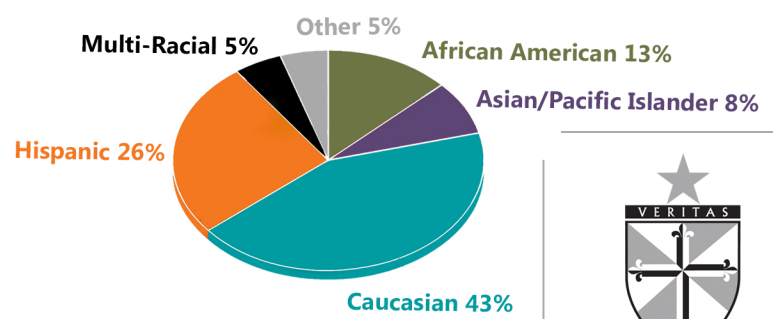

St. Pius X High School operates on an academic semester calendar with eight periods in a day.

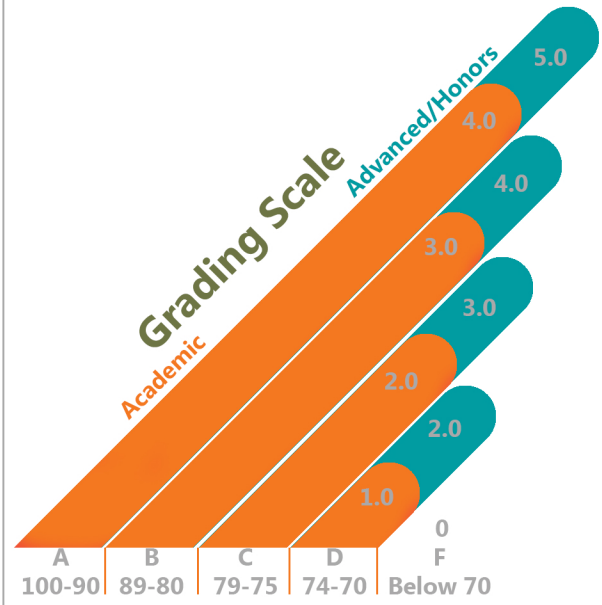


Enrollment

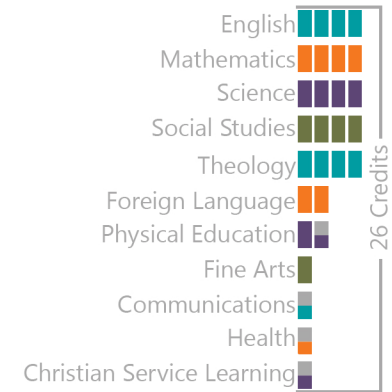

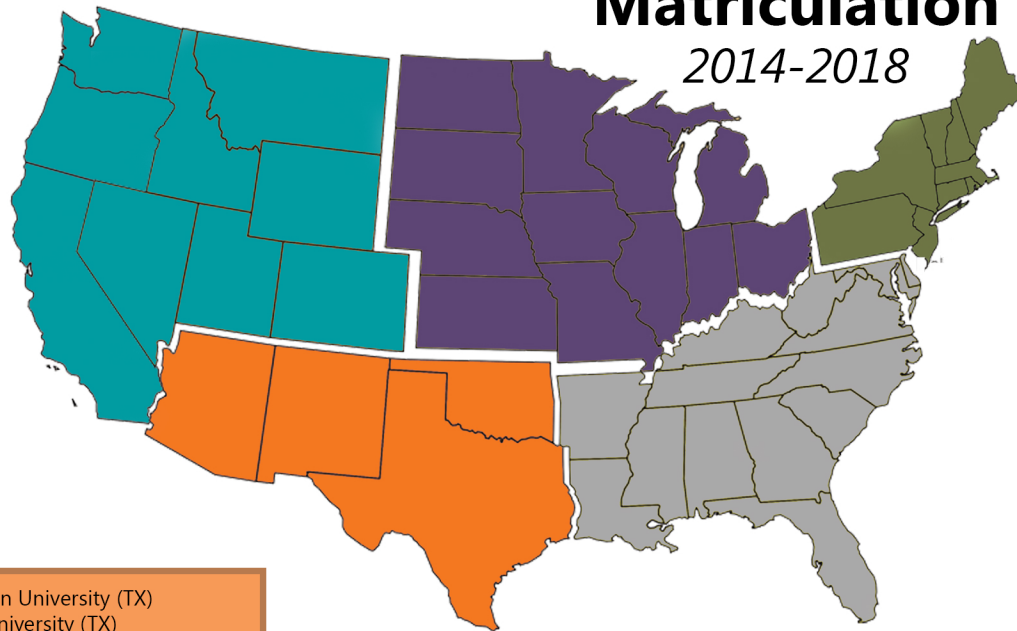

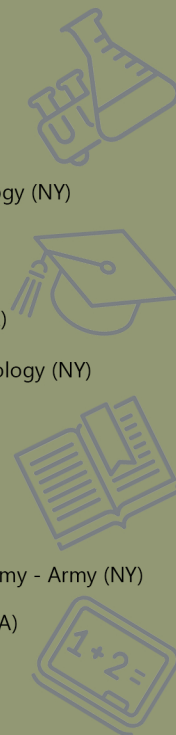
