

Senior Celebration (Dinner and Dave and Buster's) Dress Code Must Return to Ms. McGee by Tuesday, May 4, 2021

I understand the following concerning the dress code for the Senior Celebration and will abide by it. Failure to abide by the code may result in not being admitted to the Celebration. After reading the below material, please sign and return this permission form and agreement to Mrs. McGee by May 4, 2021. Your signature indicates that you understand and support compliance of the Senior Celebration dress code guidelines. Students will not be admitted to Senior Celebration without this signed contract of understanding.

Senior Celebration Dinner

Gentlemen:

- o Formal/Semi Formal dress, minimum of a coat, dress pants, shoes and shirt (tie optional).
- o All clothing must be in good repair and appropriately washed and ironed/pressed.
- o No Texas tuxedos allowed (jeans and a tux top).
- o St. Pius X men must be clean shaven. They may have a moustache. Earrings are not permitted.
- o Dress shoes must be worn no athletic shoes/slippers/etc.

Ladies:

- o A tasteful, formal dress, pantsuit, or jumpsuit is required.
- o Dresses must be at a length of mid-calf or longer. This must be 360°- all the way around!
- o Slits may hit no higher than three inches above the knee. If you purchase a dress with a slit that does not meet those guidelines, you will need to have the slit sewn.
- o No two-piece dresses are allowed.
- o Dresses too revealing, skin tight or form fitting, expose the midriff or cleavage, or too short in length are not appropriate. Administrators shall decide what is too much and that decision stands.
- Attire may not be backless, may not be see-through or have cut-outs. Covering a cut-out with fabric will
 not suffice unless that fabric is permanently sewn into the dress.
- A sheer layer revealing higher than the required mid-calf dress length or a low-cut neckline is not appropriate.
- o Attire must meet the SPX requirements without the use of cover-ups (shawls, jackets, sweaters, etc.).
- o A t-shirt and/or tights will be issued if a student's attire is deemed inappropriate.
- Before purchasing a dress, if you have questions about it meeting the guidelines, please see a senior sponsor or Mrs. Ware.
- o Dress shoes must be worn.

Senior Celebration at Dave and Buster's

- Dress is informal. Males and females are to wear long pants (jeans, sweats, pajama pants) and not shorts. It is chilly at Dave and Buster's.
- o T-shirts will be given out at the Dinner that students can wear. Sweatshirts or light jackets can be worn over the t-shirt.
- Closed toe footwear must be worn.
