**TRAVEL:** Transportation to and from the retreat site is provided by contracted charter bus service. All students are required to ride the bus to and from the retreat site. Students are not permitted to drive themselves.

**CAMP:** Camp for All is a beautiful facility where students will be housed in cabin dormitories in groups up to 14. Each cabin is equipped with full lavatories and showers, a/c and heat, electricity, and twin bunk beds. Camp for All was designed to be 100% handicap and wheelchair accessible. **MEALS:** Meals will be prepared and served by the Camp For All kitchen staff. Students with special medical, religious, dietary or nutritional needs must advise Mr. Spedale ([spedalep@stpiusx.org](mailto:spedalep@stpiusx.org)) as soon as possible and **no less than 48 hours prior** to the retreat so they may be communicated to the hospitality/meal coordinator. Do not call the campsite directly with dietary request.

**ATTIRE: NO SHORTS ALLOWED!** Students are advised to wear casual clothes in good and moderate taste. Jeans, warm-ups, are permitted. Pajamas may only be worn inside the sleeping cabins. **OPEN TOE SHOES/SANDALS OR FLIP-FLOPS ARE NOT PERMITTED at the Campsite.** Be prepared for cool and wet weather as well.

**BRING:** Each student must bring in addition to their clothing & personal toiletries, sleeping bag or twin bed linens, bath towels, a pillow, **a flashlight**, and an umbrella is also a good idea.

**LUGGAGE:** Students are permitted one carry-on bag each (not including bed-linens/sleeping bag/pillow). All bags and carry on items must be checked in the Hertzstein Gym between 7:30 and 8:00 AM on Tuesday, 3/10/20. All bags and personal items will be stored and locked in the gym until departure. All baggage and carry on items are subject to inspection by school and law enforcement authorities (Handbook p. 22 – Student Searches).

**VEHICLES:** Personal vehicles should not be left on school property while students are away on retreat. Please make arrangements to be dropped off on Tuesday, 3/10/20, or to have your vehicle picked up by a family member the same day before 6PM.

**LEAVE:** All PID'S (personal isolation devices) such as radios, i-pods, i-pads, pocket electronics of any type, **cell phones**, book-bags. Weapons, headphones, tobacco, illegal drugs, and alcohol are not permitted on the bus or at the retreat site. Neither Camp For All nor SPXHS will be responsible for the security of electronic items (including cellular phones / chargers/ i-pads et al) while on retreat at Camp For All.

**MEDS:** The Dean of Students will collect all medications before departing for the retreat. This includes both prescription medications and over-the counter-medications. All medication, prescription and non-prescription, must be presented in the original prescription bottle or manufacturer's container that includes printed dosage instructions and/or a pharmacy telephone number. Medications cannot be accepted loose, in an envelope, plastic sandwich bag, or any other container. **Only medications in their original prescription containers/packaging will be permitted.** Medication will be distributed at prescribed times by an appointed faculty or staff member of the retreat staff. Medication will only be administered to a student with the appropriate documentation. **A completed medication permission form is required.** Please note, a physician signature is required for this form. Please allow ample time to garner this signature prior to retreat.

**EMERGENCY:** In cases of extreme emergency, parents/guardians may page the Office for Campus Ministry on site at (713) 494-0390. A member of the retreat staff will return the call promptly.
